Which animal is more interesting to watch, the fly, the squirrel or the monkey? – The squirrel is more interesting to watch than the squirrel, but the monkey is the most interesting to watch.

Which animal is more difficult to find, the polar bear, the fox or the cat? - The fox is more difficult to find than the cat, but the polar bear is the most difficult to find.
