I. The Flag (Old Glory)

A. History

1. No one knows exactly, who designed the flag originally – either Congressman Francis Hopkins or a Philadelphia seamstress called Betsy Ross.
2. June 14, 1777 in order to establish an official flag for the new nation, the Continental Congress passed the First Flag Act: “Resolved, that the flag of the United States be made of thirteen stripes, alternate red and white; that the union be thirteen stars, white in a blue field, representing a new Constellation.” (...)

B. Flag Etiquette

1. Time and Occasions for display

- a. The flag should be displayed only from sunrise to sunset on buildings and on stationary flagstaffs in open.
- b. When a patriotic effect is desired, the flag may be displayed twenty-four hours a day if properly illuminated during the hours of darkness (...)
